- What personal qualities (social, emotional, physical and mental) does a person need to do well and be happy in your job?
- What things did/could you learn in school that help you most in this work?
- What can I do now to help prepare me for this job?

10. **Did your dreams come true? Why? Why not?**

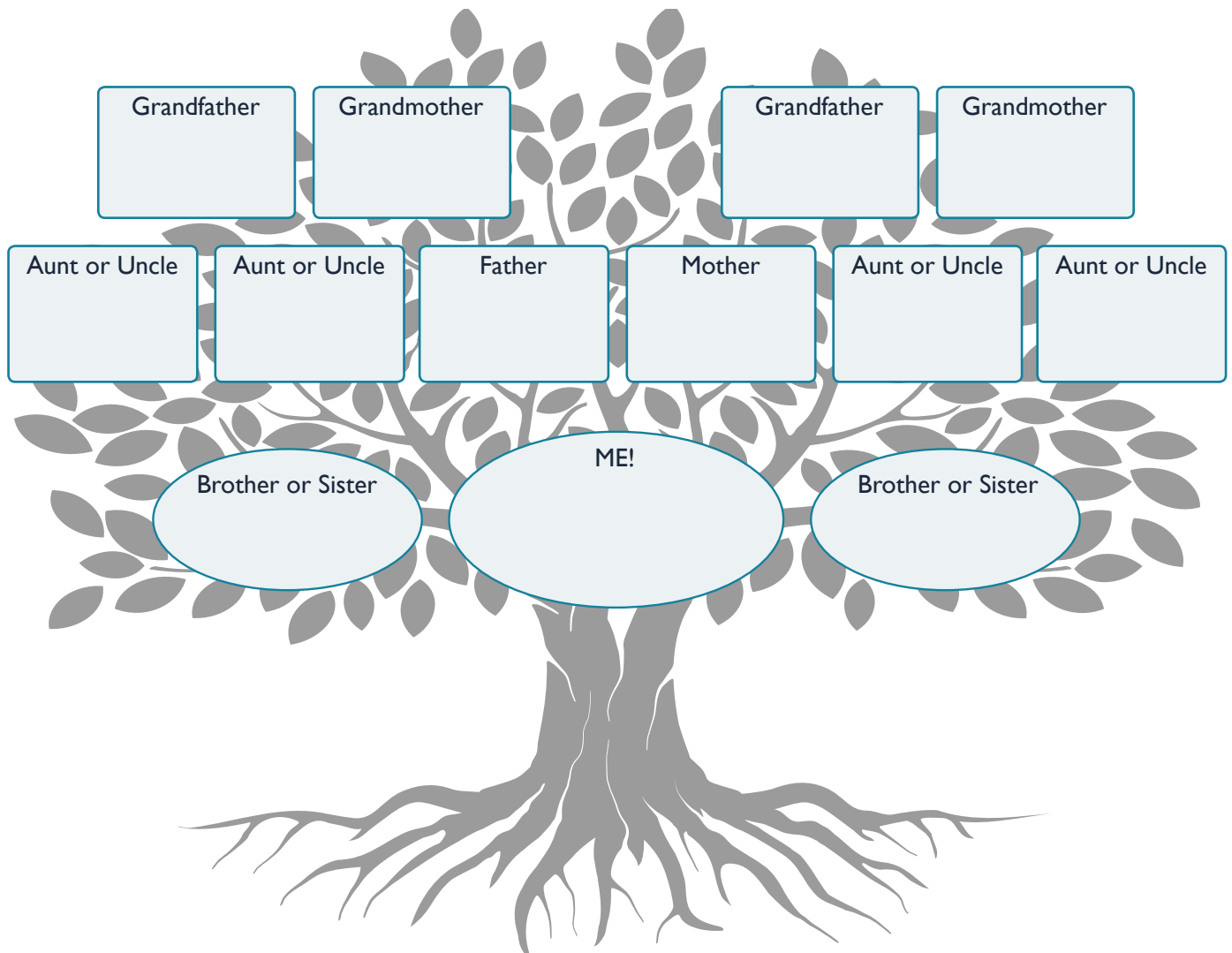
